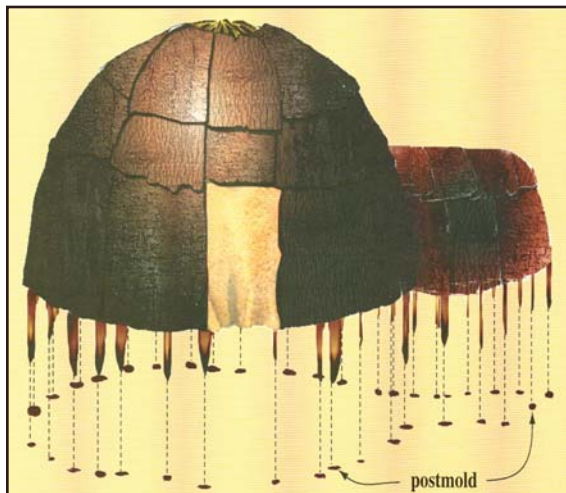
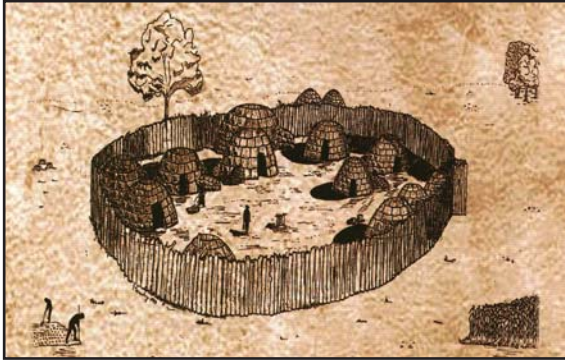


THINK like an archaeologist

Build a House!

Build a model of a Monongahela house based on the pictures below.



Ideas:

- ❖ Use a square of styrofoam as a base. Paint it green for grass or brown for dirt.
- ❖ Collect twigs or sticks from your yard to use as the frame. Push the sticks into the styrofoam to anchor your house.
- ❖ Use string or thread to tie the frame together.
- ❖ Use bark, or cut squares of cloth or brown paper grocery bags to cover your house.
